






IFFIm: past, present and future

IFFIm's launch in 2006 raised US\$ 1 billion. Since then it has raised close to US\$ 9 billion through selling bonds on the capital markets – funding that is helping Gavi have a positive, measurable impact on children's lives.



Gavi milestone: one billion children immunised

In its latest progress report, Gavi revealed that it has vaccinated one billion children around the world and is on track to immunise 300 million children between 2021 and 2025 and prevent 7 to 8 million deaths during this period, generating an additional US\$ 80 to 100 billion in economic benefits.


